Group B: Changquan, Daoshu, Jianshu, Qiangshu, Gunshu (1st Set of International Competition Taolu)  
24 Forms Taijiquan, 32 Forms Taijijian, Nanquan, Nandao (International Competition Taolu)

Group C: Changquan (No.3 Elementary Routine), Daoshu, Jianshu, Qiangshu, Gunshu (Elementary Taolu)

**Age Groups**

Group A: January 1, 1990 – December 31, 1992

Group B: January 1, 1993 – December 31, 1995

Group C: January 1, 1996 – December 31, 2001

Group A Competitors may compete in one (1) handform, one (1) short weapon, and one (1) long weapon

Group B Competitors may compete in one (1) handform, one (1) short weapon, and one (1) long weapon

Group C Competitors may compete in one (1) handform, one (1) short weapon, and one (1) long weapon

**Eligibility**

All participating athletes in this competition must abide by the age group category they fall under. Athletes must hold Canadian Citizenship.

Athletes must be a member in good standing with Wushu Canada through their provincial governing body. If the athlete's Province does not have a governing body, they must apply directly to Wushu Canada for membership.

The Eastern Qualifiers is open only to residents in Manitoba, Ontario, Quebec and the Maritime Provinces.

## Competition Method

Taolu

1. The competition shall be individual competition.
2. The competition will be conducted in accordance with the newest edition of the "Rules for International Taolu Competition" endorsed by the IWUF. There is no requirement for time limit of the Group B and Group C competitors.
3. The right of interpretation of the Rules rests solely with the IWUF. In case of disagreement in interpretation of the Rules, the Chinese Text shall prevail.

## Costumes and Equipment:

1. Competitors shall wear required taolu competition costumes during all the competitions.
2. All equipment and facilities at the competition and training sites must be in conformity with the Competition Rules.
3. Competitors shall bring their own competition apparatus for their respective events.

## Placing and Awards

a. Taolu:

The top eight places of each event will be awarded as follows:

## Team Selection Format

The Eastern Canada National Junior Team will comprise of the top 3 athletes in each respective category based on their overall mark. The athlete's overall mark will be their handform mark added together with their highest weapons mark.

Selected Team members will be eligible to represent the Eastern Canada Region at the **National Junior Championships** to be held in British Columbia on **September 21, 2008**.

## Entries

2-3 Events: \$80 (Cheques Made Payable to **Wushu Ontario**)

After June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2008 \$120.00, no registrations accepted after July 7<sup>th</sup>, 2008.
