GENERAL INFORMATION AND RULES

1. DATE AND PLACE

The competition for the 2011 Canadian National Wushu/kung Fu Championships will take place on August 20th-21st, 2011. Doors open to the public at 9am sharp and events will run from 9:30am-4:00pm daily, inside the Multi-Purpose Hall of the Chinese Cultural Centre (5183 Sheppard Ave., East. Scarborough, Ontario.)

3. COMPETITION EVENTS

Competitions will include the following events for males and females of all age categories:

- Wushu Taolu (Bare Hand, Short Weapon & Long Weapon Routines);
- Wushu Sanda (Combative);

Please see event categories (back page) for a detail breakdown of individual events and codes.

Events will be competed in 2 categories:

1. Senior National Championships: For qualified competitors representing a recognized Provincial Wushu Sport Organization seeking National Ranking and Team Recognition for the 11th World Wushu Championships to take place in Ankara Turkey in October 2011.
2. Junior National Championships: For qualified competitors representing a recognized Provincial Wushu Sport Organization seeking National Ranking and Team Recognition for the 4th World Junior Wushu Championships to take place in 2012.

4. PARTICIPATION ELIGIBILITY

National Championships Events:

Wushu Taolu

- Must be registered as Competitive Athlete for their WushuCanada membership status under their applicable Provincial Sport Organization (PSO)
- Must be affiliated with a WushuCanada recognized member club through their PSO
- A Taolu competitor may enter a maximum of three (3) individual events and (1) dual event

Wushu Sanda

- Must be registered as Competitive Athlete for their WushuCanada membership status under their applicable Provincial Sport Organization (PSO)



- Must be affiliated with a WushuCanada recognized member club through their PSO
- Sanda athletes must meet all medical and competition policies of WushuCanada

**5. REGISTRATION FEE (To be paid through participant's member club or organization)
National Championship Taolu and Sanda Combative Events:**

Sanda Events: \$95.00

Taolu Events: \$95.00 (maximum of 3 individual events plus 1 dual event)

- National Champions in each respective age or weight category from the **2010** National Championships are exempt from registration fees.
- Teams and athletes are responsible for their own accommodations, food and transportation.
- Club please make cheque or money order payable to: **WushuCanada**.

6. REGISTRATION DEADLINE

PRELIMINARY registrations must be **received in office through in person drop off or by mail to WushuCanada before 12PM Eastern Time, on August 5th, 2011.**

FINAL registration forms along with payment must be **received in office through in person drop off or by mail to WushuCanada before 12PM Eastern Time, on August 11th, 2011.** The required preliminary registration forms must be completed along with two passport size photos if we do not already have one on record (email us to confirm).

A \$100.00 administration charge will apply to those athletes who submit after the deadline. No registrations will be accepted after August 15th, 2011.

9. DRAW LOTS CEREMONY

- The Draw Lots Ceremony, for Taolu, will be held at noon on Wednesday, August 18th, 2011, at the WushuCanada headquarters.
 - The bout allocations for Sanda will be conducted by the Chief Official of the competition by Tuesday, August 17th, 2010 and posted the following day. Bouts are matched by the chief official according to experience and athletes fight record.
- The ceremony will be presided over by representatives of WushuCanada. Each team may send a representative to attend the Taolu draw. The Technical Committee will draw on behalf of athletes that are unable to send a representative and shall be recorded for archive purposes.

10. PLACING AND AWARDS

National Ranking Wushu Competition Events:

- Top 3 athletes in each individual event will receive a medal and certificate of achievement
- Top 8 athletes in overall National Rankings for each age group will receive a Certificate of achievement
- 2011 Canadian National Wushu Team will be selected based on the combined 2 highest scores of the individual athlete and can be a combination of barehand and/or weapons routines. The number of athletes selected shall be according to IWuF regulations.
- Selected athletes shall have the opportunity to represent Canada at the IWuF 11th World Wushu Championship to be held from October 6-15, 2011 in Ankara, Turkey.
- All top ranked athletes of each category shall be awarded Title of 2011 Canadian National Champion and shall receive registration exemption towards the following years National Wushu Championship.

National Wushu Sanda Competition Events:

- Champion of each weight division will receive a medal and certificate of achievement
- First runner-up and Second runner-up of each weight division will receive a medal and certificate of achievement



- 2011 Canadian National Wushu Team will be selected based on the winner of each applicable weight category.
- Selected athletes shall have the opportunity to represent Canada at the IWuF 11th World Wushu Championship to be held from October 6-15, 2011 in Ankara, Turkey.
- All top ranked athletes of each category shall be awarded Title of 2011 Canadian National Champion and shall receive registration exemption towards the following years National Wushu Championship.
- ALL PARTICIPANTS SHALL RECEIVE A CERTIFICATE OF PARTICIPATION.

11. ARBITRATION

Wushu Ontario will establish an Arbitration Committee for the purpose of resolving disputes of competitions. A \$100 (non-refundable) fee and a written complaint must be submitted to the Arbitration Committee within one hour of the completion of the event. However, prior to the completion of the competition, the athlete or the coach must inform the Chief Judge that a complaint will be filed. Decisions made by the Arbitration Committee are considered final.

12. NATIONAL RANKING TAOLU COMPETITION CATEGORIES

Age Groups:

Group A: January 1, 1994 – December 31, 1997

Group B: January 1, 1997 – December 31, 1999

Group C: January 1, 2000 – December 31, 2005

Senior: Birth Date prior to August 21, 1993 (Sanda)

In Taolu competition all ages are eligible to compete at the senior level if they choose to do so provided they meet the technical requirements of competition.

The National Ranking Events will be conducted in accordance with the 2005 Rules for International Wushu Taolu Competition endorsed by the IWUF. Requirements for difficulty components and compulsory movements in overall performance will be assessed for routines as applicable. Please refer to your coach for any clarifications. Selected athletes to the Canadian National Wushu Team must provide a valid life insurance certificate, valid passport, and valid medical certificate including an ECG and EEG test for the World Championships.

13. SANDA COMPETITIONS AND PARTICIPANTS

Age Groups and Weight Categories: Please refer to Sanda Forms for detail. (S Forms)

At registration, it is **mandatory** that all Sanda competitors (except for Non-contact Level II) present a valid WushuCanada endorsed health certificate issued by a qualified medical doctor in Canada. The certificate must be no older than 12 months old and must clearly state that the competitor is in good health and able to compete.

All Sanda Athletes must also provide the following medical results according to their class category that must be no older than 12 months old.

Class A/B/C Athletes: Blood Test Results, ECG **Non-Contact Level II:** No medical required

14. CODE OF CONDUCT FOR ALL COACHES AND ATHLETES

Complete respect, first and foremost, amongst all athletes competing against each other.

Coaches should lead by example and advise their athletes regardless the outcome; they must



always respect themselves, their fellow competitors, coaches, and most importantly the **judges**. The behaviors of the athletes are a direct reflection of the coach and it is the responsibility of the coaches to make sure that the athletes conduct themselves in a responsible and respectful manner to all bodies within the competition. If the coach is leading in a non-conductive manner of sportsmanship, it is the right of the organizing committee to have this member suspended and/or removed from the premises of all WushuCanada sanctioned events.

15. COMPETITION METHOD

a. Taolu

- i. The Competition shall be individual competition.
- ii. The competition will be conducted in accordance with the newest edition of the "Rules for International Taolu Competition" endorsed by the IWUF. There is no requirement for time limit of the Group B and Group C competitors.
- iii. The right of interpretation of the Rules rests solely with the WushuCanada. In case of disagreement in interpretation of the Rules, the Head Judge's decisions shall prevail.
- iv. Head Judge: Mr. Alexander Kwok

b. Sanda

- i. The Competition shall be individual competition.
- ii. The knockout system will be adopted. If the number of competitors is 4 (exclusive of 4) or less, the single round-robin will be adopted.
- iii. The competition will be conducted in accordance with the Class A Rules in newest edition of the "Rules for Canadian Sanda Competition" endorsed by WushuCanada.
- iv. The power of interpretation of the Rules rests solely with the WushuCanada. In the case of disagreement in the interpretation of the Rules, the Chief Officials decisions shall prevail.

Sanshou Senior Men's Team Selection Weight Categories

(In Open Class Competition, athletes shall be matched based on weight +/- 5kg)

- Bantam weight for athlete weighing 60kg & under
- Feather weight for athlete weighing >60kg to 65kg
- Light weight for athlete weighing >65kg to 70kg
- Welter weight for athlete weighing >70kg to 77kg
- Middle weight for athlete weighing >77kg to 85kg
- Heavy weight for athlete weighing over 85kg

Sanshou Senior Women's Team Selection Weight Categories

- Bantam weight for athlete weighing 52kg & under
- Feather weight for athlete weighing >52kg to 60kg
- Light weight for athlete weighing >60kg to 68kg
- Welter weight for athlete weighing >68kg to 75kg
